Spectrum Strong is a high quality durable synthetic studded rubber flooring system with a low profile for easy maintenance. Suitable for a wide range of high traffic areas.

1. PREVENTATIVE MEASURES

In common with most floor coverings, it is important to avoid abrasive materials either in the cleaning process or from being tracked onto the floor. Careful attention to suitable dirt barrier zones at entrances will reduce maintenance requirements and enhance the life and appearance of the floor. We recommend Nuway, Boardwalk, Excellence and Portal Plus matting systems and incorporating these areas into routine cleaning procedures

2. INITIAL TREATMENT

Always consider the advantages of an automatic scrubber in large areas as labour saving and carry out initial treatment to protect the flooring as soon as possible. Wash floors with Spectrum Clean & Strip diluted to suit to remove construction soiling etc. and then rinse with clean water. Immediately after the initial cleaning apply Spectrum R1000 diluted with water in a ratio of 1:50 by the wet-wipe system and leave to dry. This will not alter the degree of shine or slip resistance properties but will simplify the regular maintenance.

3. ROUTINE CLEANING AND CARE

As conditions require sweep or vacuum and damp mop with twin buckets and squeeze press with Spectrum R1000 diluted with water in a ratio of 1:200. To remove black heel marks, stains or heavy spot soiling use Spectrum Elatex, a universal spot cleaner, following the instructions.

4. INTENSIVE CLEANING

As required (e.g. annually) or when routine cleaning is not satisfying, treat floors as suggested in initial treatment.

5. WARNING

Avoid pigments, oils, fat, grease and bitumen which can cause floor failure or indelible marks. Do not use soft soaps, waxes, solvents or aggressive abrasive discs and do not wash in direct sunlight. Failure to observe these instructions can void any warranties issued.
